Guardians who are ill should only leave or pick up children in preschool or school if this can be done without the risk of others becoming infected.

I ask you to clarify what you mean when you write this? In what ways / methods can a parent leave or pick up a child without the risk of spreading?

If it is not possible to do this safely, then should the child stay home from school? For example, if the child can not go into preschool or school without an adult?

I also wonder what day the family isolation for adults takes effect, I did not see it in the news and could not find that information on your website. Thanks again!

Hello,

Thank you for your e-mail.

If a guardian has established or suspected covid-19, the guardian can transport, pick up and drop off their children at the preschool, if this can be done without close contact with others.

If drop-off / pick-up cannot take place with a physical distance, the child must not be in preschool.
